Purchase and fitting of 2 no trespassing signs

Update electrical safety certificate communal electrics in meter room.

Repair of the wall in the car park.

Servicing of the gate (though that now needs a new control box).

There has also been an increase in our gardening fees, largely due to them now charging VAT.
